- 2. Detailed outline listing each project or item to be included in the project and its proposed cost.
- 3. Estimates and bids on each (or at least most) of the components of the project. as backup documentation.
- 4. Copy of the undergraduate budget, detailing the effect that the additional debt will have on each undergraduate's house bill.
- 5. Current list of the names, addresses and telephone numbers of the officers of the FSILG Alumni Corporation.
- 6. Operating statement(s) for the FSILG Alumni Corporation and the undergraduate entity listing the annual budget, assets and liabilities.
- 7. Secretary's Certificate of Vote authorizing the FSILG Alumni Corporation to borrow a stated amount, and the President and/or Treasurer to execute and deliver a note and mortgage to secure the note. (See attached sample.)
- 8. Certificate of non-discrimination. (See attached sample.)
- 9. Copy of the By-Laws.
- 10. Certified copies of both the current Certificate of Legal Existence and the most recent Annual Report filed with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Corporation Division.
